



HIGHFIELD SQUASH CLUB (HFSC) JUNIOR MEMBER RULES



- ✓ Approved eye guards **MUST** be worn on court by all juniors at **ALL** times
- ✓ All juniors must be supervised in HFSC by an adult who is responsible for them after 9pm each day
- ✓ In the interests of safety, junior members are not permitted to be on their own in HFSC
- ✓ Junior members are not allowed access to the bar area after 6pm each day unless accompanied by an adult. They are not permitted in the bar area at all after 9pm
- ✓ juniors at the discretion of the club captains & on the advice of coaches maybe allowed play in the adult box matches & club championship matches organised by the men's & ladies' captain. For U16 players a parent/guardian must be present during these matches. If no parent/guardian is present then no match takes place & a walk over is awarded to the adult player.
- ✓ Any HFSC box games involving junior members must have an adult in attendance who is responsible for the junior(s) involved
- ✓ All squash games should be played in a competitive but fair manner
- ✓ Each junior agrees never to divulge the unique name and PIN no. associated with their membership and online system access to any other person
- ✓ Respect must be shown to all members of the club, and the rules of the club must be abided by. Breaches of HFSC rules will be discussed by the committee and sanctions imposed accordingly
- ✓ Respect must be shown to coaches, officials and referees, and their decisions must be accepted and abided by
- ✓ All juniors should refrain from behaving in a manner which brings the game of squash and/or HFSC into disrepute, both on and off the court
- ✓ All juniors should refrain from the use of bad language, inappropriate gestures and ball/racquet abuse
- ✓ No food or drink is allowed in the squash courts (PTO)



HIGHFIELD SQUASH CLUB (HFSC) JUNIOR MEMBER RULES



- ✓ All juniors should treat HFSC with respect and treat its facilities well. This particularly applies to the clubs computer system and fob keypads, which are critically important to the running of the club. It also applies but is not limited to the courts, changing rooms, heaters, notice boards, viewing areas, etc.
- ✓ Appropriate squash attire must be worn on court by juniors, particularly non-marking shoes
- ✓ All juniors must use their own gender-specific changing rooms, and always ensure that these areas are clean and tidy after use
- ✓ The club's visitors policy applies equally well to junior members as it does to other members of the club
- ✓ Any issues should be directed to the club's Children's Officer or any committee member immediately
